Dear Judge Berman:

We write in response to the Court's Order dated January 18, 2018, by which the Court directed counsel for Mr. Atilla to include in our written submissions in connection with his sentencing "a description of all non attorney client privileged contacts (i.e., meetings, calls, texts, emails etc.) by all counsel, including Turkish counsel, with any officials of the United States and/or Turkish governments and relating to the prosecution and/or disposition of this case." *See* Order dated Jan. 18, 2018 (Dkt. # 442).

First, counsel for Mr. Atilla have had no contacts with U.S. government officials in connection with this case other than members of the prosecution team and those officials with whom it was necessary to communicate with regard to our *Touhy* requests and trial subpoenas.

Mr. Atilla's counsel's contacts with Turkish government officials in connection with this case are detailed in the two charts attached to this letter as Exhibits A and B. Exhibit A details interactions of Mr. Atilla's attorneys at the firm of Herrick, Feinstein LLP ("Herrick") with Turkish government officials. None of Mr. Atilla's U.S. attorneys at firms other than Herrick have had any contacts with Turkish government officials in connection with Mr. Atilla's case.

As shown in Exhibit A, the Herrick attorneys' interactions with Turkish government officials have been limited to representatives of the Turkish Consulate in New York. In nearly all instances, these contacts have related to administrative and logistical matters. On a couple of occasions, counsel has responded to requests from consulate representatives for assistance in understanding aspects of Mr. Atilla's case and the American justice system. On another occasion, on September 28, 2017, as noted in Exhibit A, counsel at Herrick inquired of the Turkish Consul General in New York as to whether the Republic of Turkey would consider making an official request with the U.S. Department of State that Mr. Atilla be afforded common law immunity as a foreign official given the acts alleged in the indictment (S4) and his employment by a state-owned bank. Ultimately, the Turkish Embassy in Washington, DC sent a

diplomatic note regarding Mr. Atilla to the U.S. Department of State. While the Turkish diplomatic note related to Mr. Atilla's prosecution, it did not include a formal request that Mr. Atilla be afforded common law immunity as a foreign official.

Mr. Atilla's Turkish attorney's contacts with Turkish government officials are detailed in Exhibit B. These contacts, similar to those of the Herrick attorneys, primarily relate to administrative, ministerial matters involving representatives of the Turkish Consulate in New York. Mr. Atilla's Turkish attorney has also met on one occasion each, and at their request, both with the Turkish Justice Minister and the Turkish Ambassador to the U.S. He also met once with a representative of the Turkish Ministry of Justice regarding the facilitation of Rule 15 depositions of potential witnesses to be conducted in Turkey on behalf of the defense. The Rule 15 depositions that were contemplated never took place.
